



EPSO competitions and selection procedures consist of a series of tests designed to evaluate several competencies.

The Notice of Competition is the only official document providing detailed information about the exact tests used by EPSO for each competition. All Notices are published in the Official Journal of the European Union.





Recruitment by EU institution

Once all the competition steps are finalised and the outcome validated, "a reserve list" is established. This **shortlist** contains successful **candidates ready to be recruited.**

Reserve lists are valid at least one year but may be and have often been extended.
Institutions with vacancies consults the list for a suitable person, the candidate is interviewed and a job offer may follow.

Candidates can chose to accept an offer or to decline - and instead remain available on the list.
Successful candidates are advised to actively pursue opportunities and improve skills, like language proficiency, while waiting.


